**Accommodation**

Housing - homeless UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client has nowhere to live; someone is not homeless if they are in temporary accommodation

Housing - temporary accommodation UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client is living in temporary accommodation, this includes hostel accommodation, sofa surfing, or short-term arrangements outside the family

Housing - unsuitable housing UNASSIGNED

Assign

They client feels they are living in unsuitable accommodation, this might be because it is unsafe, unsanitary, overcrowded, or in disrepair

**Domestic abuse**

Disclosed domestic violence and abuse UNASSIGNED

Assign

Client who self-reports that they are or have been subject to domestic violence and abuse

**Environment**

**Outdoor spaces** ASSIGNED

The client reports that they have not taken a visit to the natural environment for health or exercise over the previous seven days

Noise UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client reports that excessive noise is having an adverse effect on their health. 'Noise' includes environmental, neighbour, and neighbourhood

Environment - Community safety UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client reports that they do not feel safe in their own homes or their community

**Family**

Caring responsibilities - lack of access to replacement or respite care UNASSIGNED

Assign

Client who is a carer and the cost of replacement or respite care exceeds the financial benefit of working and/or training

**Financial hardship**

Financial hardship UNASSIGNED

Assign

Client who self-discloses that they have unmanaged debt, rent arrears, or low income

**Health**

Late diagnosis UNASSIGNED

Assign

People at the end of life who were not diagnosed in a timely way

**Safeguarding**

Vulnerable adult UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client meets the criteria for a vulnerable adult

**Social isolation**

Social isolation UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client has no support from partner, family, or friend

**Behaviour**

**Alcohol**

Alcohol UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client is drinking more than the recommended units of alcohol per week on average: 14 for women, 21 for men, 4 for pregnant women

**Smoking**

Smoking UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client smoked cigarettes in the last week, regardless of number per day

**Substance misuse**

Substance misuse UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client regularly uses intoxicants (excluding alcohol) to an extent where physical dependence or harm is a risk

Assign

Client who reports that they have not independently looked for a job and submitted a job application online

**Health**

**Religious and spiritual needs not met**

Assign

People who self-report that they have not been offered spiritual and religious support appropriate to their needs and preferences

**Health check**

High blood pressure UNASSIGNED

Assign

The client has a blood pressure reading over 140/90

**Raised blood pressure**

Assign

The client has a blood pressure reading of between 120/80 and 140/90

Assign

Clients who are not being treated in their preferred place of care

**Death in usual place of residence**

Assign

The client is assessed with mild to severe frailty

**Mental health****Dementia**

Clients with dementia

**Low wellbeing**

Assign

The client has a low sense of wellbeing, as indicated by their result on either WEMWBS or the GNS Measuring National Well-being Programme

**Weight****Obese**
