Accomodation

Housing - homeless

Assign

Housing - temporary accomodation

Housing - unsuitable housing

Not Engaged in a Work Focussed Activity

Assign

Client who is not currently engaged in a work focused activity

Exercise

Physically inactive

The client is doing less than 30 minutes of moderately intense physical activity per week in bouts of 10 minutes or more

Moderately physically active

Assign

UNASSIGNED

The client is doing more than 30 minutes but less than 150 minutes of moderate intensity physical activity per week

Independence

Requires help with control over daily life

The client reports that they have some control over their daily lives but not enough

Language

Difficulty speaking English

Client reports that they have difficulty speaking, reading, writing or understanding English

The client regularly uses intoxicants (excluding alcohol) to an extent where physical dependence or harm is a risk

Health check

High blood pressure

Sexual health

STI

Assign

The client is identified as having a sexually transmitted infection
