Meets the troubled family criteria
ASSIGNED

Client who lives in a household where a Troubled Family has been identified.

Caring responsibilities - lack of access to replacement or respite care

Client who is a carer and the cost of replacement or respite care exceeds the financial benefit of working and/or training

Financial hardship

Stress and Anxiety

UNASSIGNED
